OFFICIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to first year apprentices and pre-apprentice students pursuing a Union Apprenticeship for the trades or trade related education & training pertaining to their apprenticeship/pre-apprenticeship education as approved by the Foundation board in the Puget Sound area of Washington State.

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

1. Applicant must be accepted in a Union Apprenticeship for the Puget Sound building trades or be an accepted pre-apprentice in a recognized apprenticeship-entry program such as that offered by City Light, Seattle Vocational Institute, Renton Technical College, ANEW or South Seattle Community College, or be pursuing approved trade related education course work applicable to their particular situation at an approved local institution or JATC program.
2. The application must be postmarked by **Wednesday, December 23, 2009** to be considered for an award.
3. The Katharina Engnell Foundation Board of Trustees shall make the scholarship selections. Awards are based on three categories: financial need, the student's essay, and student's community involvement & achievement.
4. Payment of the award shall be made directly to the trust or institution administering the applicant's training/education program.
5. The granting of a scholarship shall be partially based on an original essay of 500 words or less. For this year's essay, applicants may choose between two topics: (1) "How can the union movement reach out to the next generation of workers in this country?" (2) "How will union membership benefit your life and how will you pass it on and help others?"

- 2) The address of the apprenticeship program and/or institution.

- 4) At least one letter of recommendation, preferably from someone involved with the craft or field the student is entering.
- 5) Copies of high school and college transcripts.
- 6) Documentation of community service & involvement by the applicant, with special emphasis on working people's issues & needs.

The committee reserves the right to meet and review these policies yearly, to determine if any alterations are necessary. Any suggestions that Union members have to improve this application form should be referred to the Katharina Engnell Foundation in writing, signed and dated.
