#3) NEW Update on Teamsters Local 174 Strike!

The Teamsters Union Local 174 strike is ongoing with NO END in sight. Negotiations are ongoing, but with little progress. This strike has impacted all major Union construction projects and has led to many of our members being placed on stand-by or laid off.

Now the situation has become worse, as many general contractors are using non-union concrete companies and 'replacement drivers' to displace the Union Teamsters. This has led to many moving picket lines, and jobs shut down.

Many of you will continue to see picket lines on your projects when non-union concrete is used. An injury to one is an injury to ALL!

Thanks to your will and support, we continue our coordinated efforts with our Building Trades and other labor and community allies, to apply pressure on the employers to return to the bargaining table and negotiate a fair contract!

When the Teamsters return to work, our members on stand-by and those unemployed can return to work.

We need the mud to flow again!

All submissions will be reviewed to confirm all applicants meet the position requirements. Applicants will be contacted the week of April 4, 2022, to begin scheduling interviews.

The Interview process shall be as follows:

- ALL Qualified applicants shall have initial interview by a panel of five (5) people to include Staff Organizers, and Business representatives
- Interview panel will determine list of finalists
- Finalists will advance to second round of interviews (if needed)
- Business Manager and Interview Panel shall review and interview finalists
- Final candidate MUST be able to fit in with current Staff Team!
- Business Manager will have the OPTION to select the NEW Staff Organizer!

This process and interview DO NOT guarantee a candidate will be selected from given pool.
